This month we will be taking possession of our new Logistics centre based in Birstall, just a few miles from Leeds in the North of England. The fascility is 17500 sq feet in total. 3500 sq ft will be allocated to office space which will include a small design centre for architects and designers to use and view our

products on display. In addition we will have a testing rig set up to check flow rates and optimum water pressures, plus a training area.

We are also increasing our "back office" support team to help Jackie Heseltine, our Leeds based Operations Manager, with additional Sales Admin, Warehouse personnel, drivers and technical support.

We hope to move from our current UK warehouse by the end of September, and mid to late October move the office based staff to the new facility by which time we will have the new furniture, central heating etc in place.



This is a big move and investment for us as we plan to supply many of our new territories ie North and West Africa, CIS countries etc from UK allowing our customers to take advantage of receiving shipments from England, plus of course service our existing customers both in UK and Europe.

Clients are also welcome in the showroom either with their consultants or by appointment for personal service.

The parties have also signed a MoU to open 5 further A&D Showrooms in China in 2014 and one in Singapore. With all the Global Launch of the new Collections happening in the Hong Kong store there will be plenty of choice from modern to traditional to please everyone. This partnership is the first step for BAGNODESIGN in its venture to move into the Asia Pacific market and represents a key part of the companies growth strategy in the medium term.
